Selenium is a micronutrient that may be lacking in some home grown feeds and unless supplementation is used nutritional muscular dystrophy may result. In some areas the soil may contain an excess of selenium and supplementation is to be avoided in such areas except on veterinary advice.

Symptoms of Selenium Deficiency in cattle include goitre, late abortion, stillbirth, weak calves at birth, calving problems (retained placenta, slow calving), infertility (repeat-breeders, silent heat), decreased resistance to disease (animals prone to pneumonia, scour, joint-ill, parasitism, mastitis, metritis), unthrifty appearance, poor weight gain, white muscle disease, lameness, pseudo-pneumonia, poor milk yield and sudden death. Selenium stores and recycles well in animals.

DOSE: Each AQUASEL tablet contains 35mg selenium and releases approximately 4 - 5mg per day over 7 days. It is a generous and safe supplement. Use only in cattle above 100kg liveweight. Do not use if high levels of selenium supplements are available from other sources. Excess inputs of selenium can cause TOXICITY.

Cows & adult cattle (550kg up):	1 tablet / animal / week.
Cattle 250kg:	1 tablet / 2 animals / week.
Calves 100kg:	1 tablet / 5 calves / week.

OTHER ANIMALS: Contact Mayo Healthcare.

ADMINISTRATION: Use AQUASEL as recommended by your veterinary adviser, or treat the water supply to the cattle for 4 - 6 weeks before calving and for 10 - 12 weeks after calving (especially in the 4 weeks before service and throughout the breeding season).

NOTE: AQUASEL tablets still retain their shape after 7 days. Each week the old spent tablets must be replaced with new tablets.
